Due to the increased concern of spreading COVID in public places, Hellstead Manor will be taking extra precautions to help keep our guests and employees safe

We are closely following Pennsylvania government safety regulations and CDC guidelines to keep update to date on the latest practices and make any necessary changes to our plans as needed

The purpose of this document is to outline key components of the safety procedure that will be in place for the 2020 season



The Safety of our visitors

Hellstead Manor Management is constantly monitoring any changes in safety recommendations from the CDC and will adjust our safety protocol as needed throughout the season. The inside of the haunt has been modified to so the number of surfaces that are touched has been reduced to almost none. Any surfaces that would need to be touched with be sanitized throughout each night.



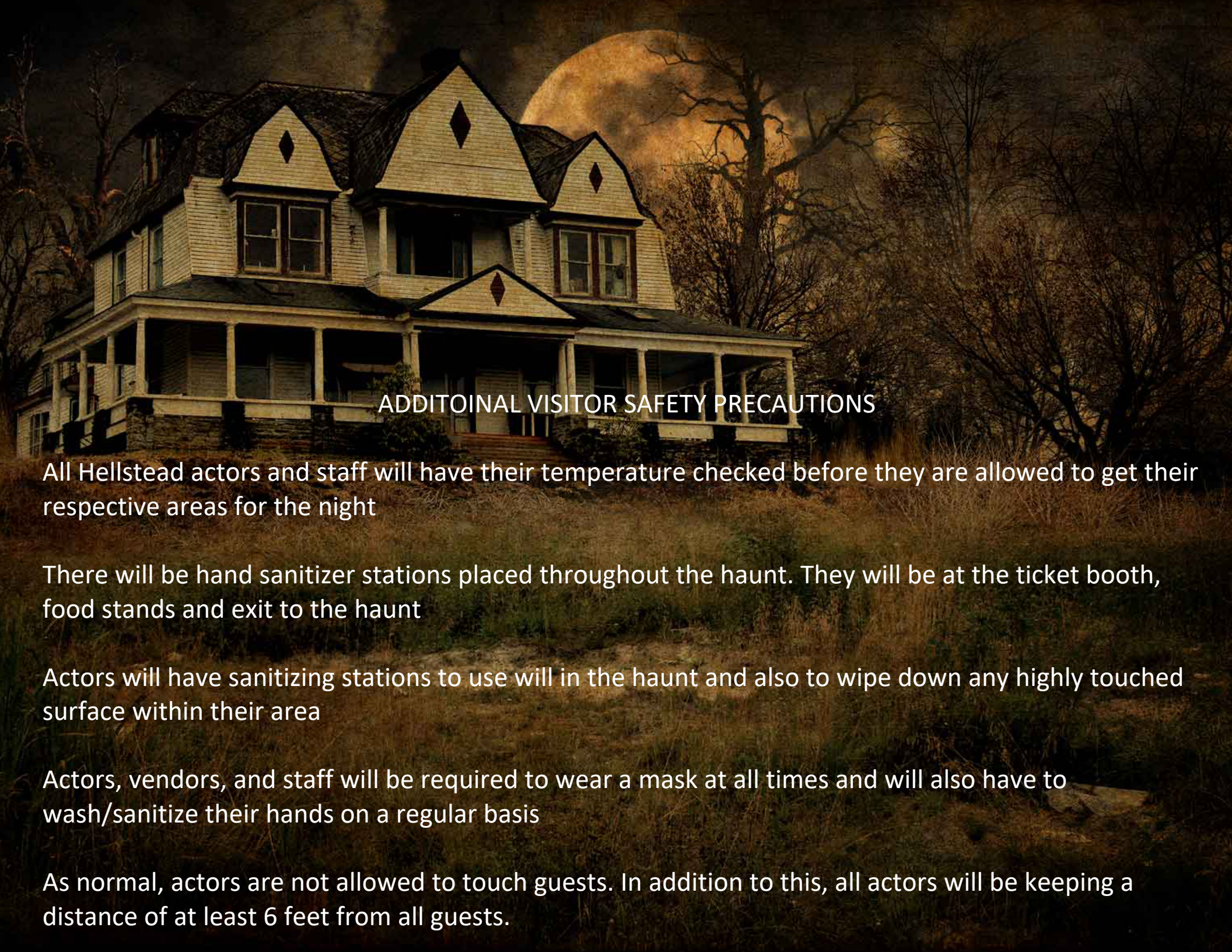
ADDITIONAL VISITOR SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

All guests must wear a mask while at Hellstead. The only time a guest will not need to wear a mask is while sitting, while eating, or drinking. If guests do not have a mask with them, one will be provided free of charge

If you have been exposed to COVID or have COVID related symptoms such as (Fever Cough, Shortness of Breath), please stay home to help prevent the spread.

Hellstead Manor's safety team will be maintaining sanitization of highly touched surfaces and highly trafficked areas. This is in addition to the sanitizing practices already in place at The Manor.



ADDITIOINAL VISITOR SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

All Hellstead actors and staff will have their temperature checked before they are allowed to get their respective areas for the night

There will be hand sanitizer stations placed throughout the haunt. They will be at the ticket booth, food stands and exit to the haunt

Actors will have sanitizing stations to use will in the haunt and also to wipe down any highly touched surface within their area

Actors, vendors, and staff will be required to wear a mask at all times and will also have to wash/sanitize their hands on a regular basis

As normal, actors are not allowed to touch guests. In addition to this, all actors will be keeping a distance of at least 6 feet from all guests.



With these safety measures in place, we hope to make our guests feel comfortable with their surrounds and give them some excitement this Halloween season
